ASSEMBLY OF MB-2-2542 MOBILE MAINTENANCE BENCH


The only assembly required is attaching casters to the bench. Approximate assembly time: 5-10 minutes.

Tools required: slotted screwdriver and 7/16" wrench.


The reference numbers used throughout this sheet refer to the illustration on the back cover.

This is to help you to identify the various parts as they are mentioned.

1. Place the cabinet (Ref. No. 1) upside down on a clean, stable, non-marring surface.




3. Return the workbench unit to it's upright position and lock the brakes on the swivel casters.




2. Place casters (Ref. Nos. 10 and 11) over the bolt studs provided on caster supports and attach with four Hex Nuts (Ref. No. 14) and four Lockwashers (Ref. No. 15). Tighten all the nuts securely.


NOTE: Be sure to mount the swivel casters together on the same end of the cabinet.




4. To operate the caster brakes, press down on the front of the brake with a foot to lock. Then press down on the back of the brake with a foot to unlock.
