


ASSEMBLY OF STEEL SHELVING

Tools Needed: A rubber mallet for seating the shelf supports into the uprights. Two people are recommended for assembly. Approximate assembly time: 20-30 minutes per section.


1. The reference numbers used throughout this sheet refer to the illustration on the back cover. This is to help you to identify the various parts as they are mentioned.

NOTE: All illustrations show a solid shelf. Assembly for perforated shelf is identical.

Create a unit end by connecting two uprights (Ref. No. 1 or 2) with one of the front-to-back shelf supports (Ref. No. 3) by inserting the shelf support rivets into the bottom two keyhole slots of each upright using a rubber mallet to seat the upright securely in the keyhole slots.




3. Assemble another unit end by repeating the directions in step 2. Be sure the shelf support rivets are seated in the bottom of the slots. If you are creating a starter unit and adder units then you will need to replace the EUR upright post on one end with




4. Connect two of the left-to-right shelf supports (Ref. No. 4) between the two assemblies, one on each side with angled corners facing toward each other. Be sure to use the two keyhole slots nearest the floor, as in step 1. NOTE: As in step one, make sure the flat edge of the shelf supports are facing upwards. If this has been done correctly, there would now be a flat surface around all four edges on which to lay the bottom steel shelf. If any edges have an upward facing angled edge, the support has been inserted upside down.


5. Finish installing the remaining left-to-right shelf supports and front-to-back shelf supports around the top of the unit.




6. After building the framework, place a steel shelf (Ref. No. 5) on the lower level and on the top level of the VDRS supports. These shelves will lay directly on the flat ledge of the support.




7. Next attach the ZSC-1 shelf clips (Ref. No. 6) to the EUR post as shown. Make sure that all four clips are on the same level on each of the uprights for the shelves to be level. Be sure to drive the clips down until they are seated firmly then install the shelf on top of the four clips, with the shelf sliding into the slot in the clip.





9. If you are assembling an adder unit it will not look like the drawing above. The adder unit will share front and back supports with the starter unit on the side that the starter unit is connected using an intermediate "T" post. To attach an adder unit to a starter unit you will attach the VDRS supports to the ZTP post and construct the adder unit the same way that you did the starter unit.
